



Jordan's Principle Request Prep - PEI

Use this before contacting Jordan's Principle. You do not need to decide by yourself whether a request will be approved. The purpose is to organize the child's need, eligibility information and supporting documents so the request is easier to explain.

1. Confirm the child may be eligible

- ☐ Child is under the age of majority in PEI and permanently resides in Canada.
- ☐ Child is registered or entitled to be registered under the Indian Act, OR
- ☐ Child has a parent or guardian who is registered or entitled to be registered, OR
- ☐ Child is recognized by their First Nation for Jordan's Principle purposes, OR
- ☐ Child is ordinarily resident on reserve.

2. Describe the child's specific unmet need

Health, social or educational need

What is happening now

What product, service or support is being requested

3. Supporting information

- ☐ Letter or recommendation from a health professional, educational professional, Elder or Knowledge Keeper, when relevant.
- ☐ Assessment, school plan, treatment recommendation or other document showing the child's need.
- ☐ Cost estimate or detailed cost breakdown when the request involves funding.
- ☐ Eligibility information, status / entitlement information, Nation recognition or ordinary-residence information as applicable.
- ☐ Any information explaining why the requested support is needed for substantive equality, cultural appropriateness or the child's best interests.
